Concerned Windsor Citizens Supports Change in Balance of Power

The dominance and control of the Windsor Democrats was demonstrated by their insistence on tax increase of nearly 3% following a defeat of the Budget referendum. Last week at a debate of council candidates, Windsor Republicans led by minority leader Don Jepsen, emphasized that the tax increase imposed upon Windsor taxpayers was not necessary. He maintained that the taxpayers were overcharged. Earlier this year the Republicans advised waiting for the legislature's action on the state budget and municipal aid plan. After the defeat of the spending increases by the voters, The Republicans pressed to remove the \$1 million cushion from the original budget from the tax increase. The Democrats steadfastly refused to do this.

The Town has as substantial savings account and no immediate tax increase was required to "pay our bills" as some democrats stated.

Now that the legislature has a tentative budget in place which maintains aid to Windsor, it is clear that the taxpayers were in fact overcharged.
